

# Stoke-on-Trent City Centre is home to over 100 pieces of artwork, from local muralists to award-nominated artists beyond Staffordshire's borders.


Amble, strut and explore all the creativity bursting from walls, doors, bins and more.

### **ArtJam Murals** (blue code)

### **Honouring Heritage (green code)**

Four large-scale murals sit on Hope Street, depicting important figures who have contributed to the rich heritage of our city:

Eleanor Lodge was a British academic born in Hanley in 1869. She went on to serve as principal in the University of London and the first ever female recipient of a Doctor of Letters; the highest level of college degree. Artwork completed by Ethan Lemon + Rob Fenton.

Stoke Speedway, originally formed at the Sun Street Stadium in Hanley in 1929, with 30,000+ visitors attending to watch the speedway pre-war. Artwork completed by Rob Fenton.

Edward John Smith, the legendary captain of the doomed RMS Titanic, often referred to as "the millionaire's captain" due to his popularity and skill. Artwork completed by Tom Edwards, Rob Fenton and Ethan Lemon.

Rob Fenton is a graphic designer and Staffordshire University graduate.
